WELCOME

The combined Annual Meeting of the Monterey Dunes Colony Association and the Monterey Dunes Colony Mutual Water Association was called to order by Bill Michaels, President, at 10:00 A.M., Saturday, October 20, 2012 at the Monterey Dunes Colony Clubhouse, 195 Monterey Dunes Way, Castroville, CA 95012.

HOMEOWNER INTRODUCTIONS

Homeowners present at the meeting introduced themselves.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Bill Michaels gave a verbal report recapping completed work during the past year:

- 1. We repaired the roads and parking lots throughout the colony;
- 2. Replaced six garage doors;
- 3. Replaced the entry and exit gates to the colony;
- 4. Replaced 10 built up roofs;
- 5. Replaced 23 unit decks;
- 6. Repainted the trim on a third of the units;
- 7. Completed the shingle project at a considerable savings by purchasing materials in bulk, using in-house labor, and adjusted the completion date to minimize the annual financial impact on the reserves;

- 8. Developed a strategy to repair the 212,000 gallon water storage tank using a polypropylene liner. We are currently working on the plan to re-plumb the water system to accommodate the repair to the tank and liner installation;
- 9. Re-routed the Oceanside boardwalk from unit #324 to unit #312 which will ensure the footing for water-filled barriers;
- 10. Improved relations and hosted periodic meetings with local, state and federal regulatory agencies concerning the Salinas River, Lagoon, Sensitive Habitat and Coastal Protection Strategies;
- 11. Acquired 150 yards of sand from the Water Resources Agency at no cost to the Colony, which represents a huge savings;
- 12. Overhauled and tested the emergency backup fire pump;
- 13. Replaced the emergency backup generator control panel;
- 14. Repaired a rupture in the water system distribution system.

Bob Dickinson reported that the finance committee and board have discussed an archiving project in which all office documents will be scanned into the computer and backed up to the cloud.

Next, Bill thanked the following committees for their work over the past year:

- 1. Finance committee
- 2. Wave run-up committee
- 3. Environmental control committee
- 4. Website committee
- 5. Survey committee

The final two things that Bill had to say were:

- 1. Unit #242 remains rented and the rent pays for the monthly and annual assessments. Remaining funds, after the assessments are paid, are being used to pay down the liability of prior assessments not paid.
- 2. Operating and reserve assessments did not increase from FY 2011-12 to FY 2012-13.
